JOHN F. HANDY CONSERVATION PROJECT

The 5.44 acres beside and behind the telephone building in Cataumet (see map) was under agreement with a local developer and was slated for a 4 lot subdivision. However, the developer allowed Philip DeNormandie to purchase the parcel, thus avoiding the four lot subdivision. At present the one acre lot on County Road and the acre lot on Depot Road are for sale. The remaining three and one half acres have been designated for conservation. This will be the John F. Handy Conservation Land and will be deeded to the Bourne Conservation Trust. We now have the opportunity to add the one acre lot which fronts on Depot Road to the Handy Conservation Land. This piece of property, if acquired, will form a continuation of the existing conservation property across the street (see map) and will protect the tranquil character of Cataumet's roadways.

Mr. DeNormandie has generously offered this one acre lot to the Trust at cost, thus foregoing the tremendous profit from developing it. If we are to keep this additional parcel, we must raise the money as soon as possible.

The total amount of the property is \$50,000. To date, thanks to the generosity of the immediate neighborhood there is \$30,000 in donations and pledges toward this purchase. (This represents an average donation of \$1600.00.) We need your support to raise the remaining \$20,000.

If 200 people each donated \$100 or if

10 people gave \$500,
50 people gave \$100,
125 people gave \$50, and
150 people gave \$25

then our goal of \$20,000 would be met. Of course, if 2 people gave \$10,000 each, we would have "no worries".

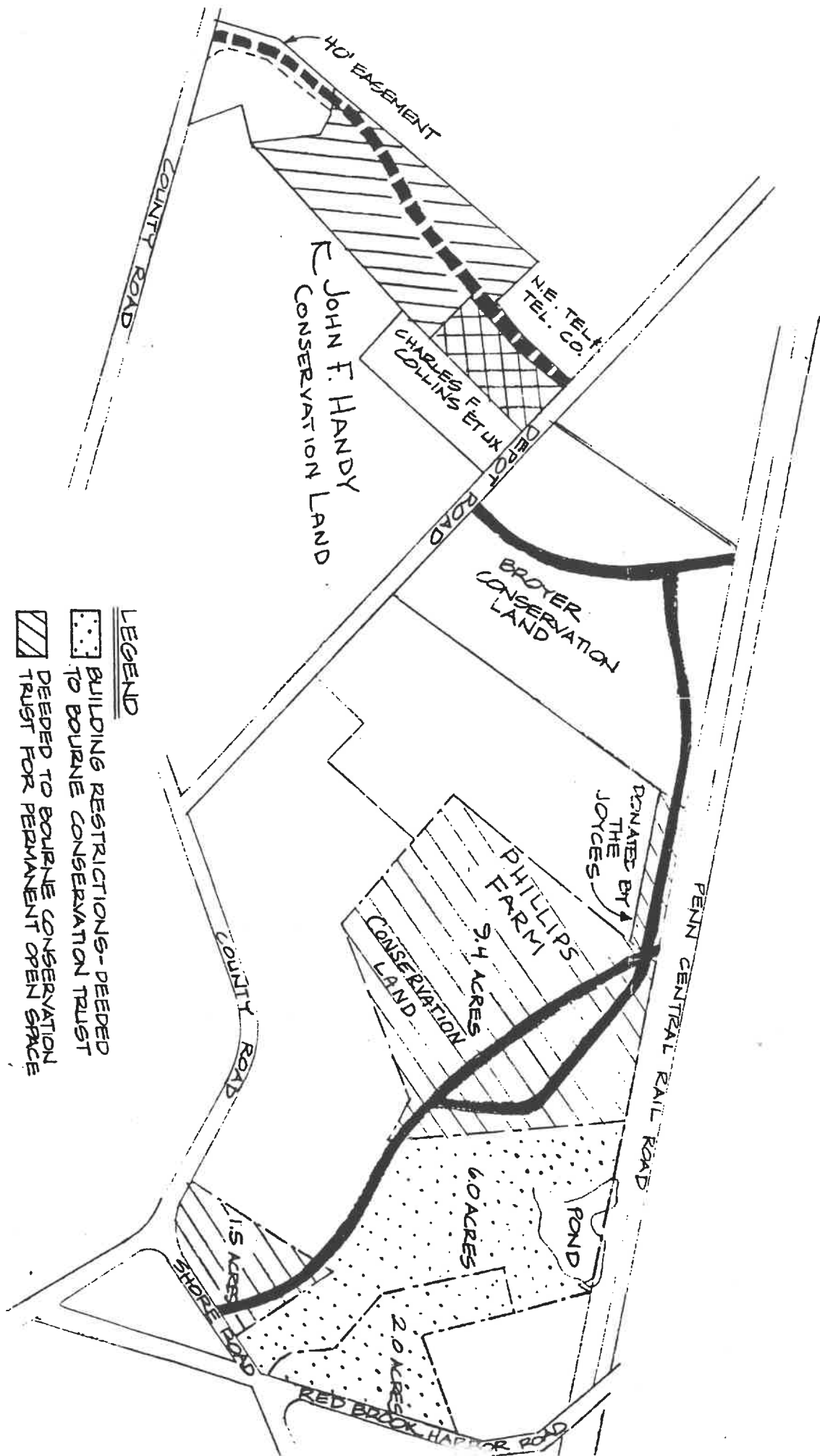

Lawrence Island Mortgage Burning--A Major Success Story!

The Bourne Conservation Trust members and all its supporters have reason to celebrate the Lawrence Island Mortgage Burning. On a beautiful Saturday afternoon, at Mrs. Alfred Thomas' residence, over 100 onlookers watched as Steve Ballentine presented Dr. Carlton Buttrick with the final payment for the nature preserve. Then, with Lawrence Island as a backdrop, the two men burned the mortgage in a special ceremony complete with cannon firing. Thanks to the generosity of the many contributors that helped raise the \$160,000 over a years time, the Island will be preserved forever. Cynthia Smith of the Conservation Commission, said this purchase was significant for it showed what a local group can do to assure open space. In five years there will be very few large open areas left in Bourne. State Rep. Thomas Cahir congratulated the Trust on its purchase. Linda Dadak and Maureen Jason presented Steve and Sally Ballentine and Philip DeNormandie with this year's Cataumet Civic Associates' Beautification Award.

The Trust has established a subcommittee to oversee the use and maintenance of the Island. The members of the committee are Steve Ballentine, Arthur Nelson, William Macurdy, John Bolton, and Richard Bryant, a representative from the Animal Rescue League of Boston.

Lawrence Island is ideal for nature hikes and educational purposes. Everyone is urged to use it and enjoy it and to treat the Island and the access to it with respect.

Land Bank Bill--This bill, if enacted, would provide a source of funds for the purchase of open space for conservation, recreation, water resource, and planned development for the Town's growth needs. The funds would be accumulated through the collection of a percentage (up to 2%) on land transactions of more than a predetermined amount within the Town. The bill is in the Senate Ways & Means Committee for consideration at the present time. This bill would be a boon to Land Conservation and we urge you to support it.

Town of Bourne Open Space Task Force--Bourne has appointed a nine member panel to identify and pursue acquisition of some of the critical undeveloped properties remaining in the Town. The Open Space Task Force needs your support in identifying these parcels and moreover in supporting the land acquisition bond issue that will be presented at our May Town Meeting.
